

# Geomantic journey 22nd - 26th June 2016 Split and Imotski led by Marko Pogacnik



## Supporting Gaia's creative impulses



This is an invitation to a geomantic journey after the Lifenet meeting with the UNESCO peace artist Marko Pogačnik.

This three-day trip offers an opportunity to get to know and experience the town and region of Split as complimentary to the island Brač. Two days will be spent in Split and one day at Imotski, a bus ride away on the border to Bosnia/Hercegovina.

The places we will visit, including Brač, form an extensive heart system which is about to materialise in this part of Europe. The various places will

be introduced according to their role within this entire heart system and in connection with one's own multidimensional heart system.


In 2015, Marko had an exhibition at the Gallery of Fine Arts in Split. In connection with this, he led a workshop in the region and thus made sure that blockages were transformed as far a possible. The aim of this journey is to support the places discovered in their function for life on Earth.



## Programme

**Wednesday, 22.6.** Transfer from Milna, Brac to Split in the evening

**Thursday, 23.6.** We will get to know the former Diocletian palace, inside of which later the medieval town of Split developed. The location of the Roman palace was chosen according to geomantic considerations and places with precious energy can be experienced there.

**Friday, 24.6.** Coach trip to Imotski (80 km), the location of two circular bodies of water, the Blue and the Red Lake. They are located in deep, wide craters. Rare are such places where the elementary presence of Gaia is so tangible.

**Saturday, 25.6.** Coach trip to three plateaus in Split. First we will visit Galvičine, where megalithic stones are located, then Sustipan at the entrance to Split harbour, with foci of angelic presence. The third plateau lies on the foot of Marjan, the mount of Split. It is a dragon's back with dolmens and various ancient chapels. From there, the group will walk back to Split, across the mount.

**Sunday, 26.6.** Departure after breakfast

## Accommodation

Accommodation will be at and around the design hostel Goli & Bosi and close to the Diocletian palace, right in the centre of Split. There is a choice of double rooms, double rooms with single occupancy and six-bed dormitories. Hostel website: [www.gollybossy.com](http://www.gollybossy.com)  
The harbour, bus and rail stations are about 10 minutes' walk away.

## Meals

The meals will be vegetarian. Breakfast will be served at the hostel every day including Sunday. Included are

three evening meals in the vegetarian Restaurant Makrovega and two snacks on the two days with bus trips. Please buy your own drinks and fruit to be eaten during the day. Supper is not included on Thursday as we will be right in the city centre, where shops, take-aways and restaurants are close.

## Language

The language will be English with translations into German and other languages are required.

## Fees

The fee for the journey is 170 Euros or 1250 Croatian Kunas. Included are:

- Transfer from Milna to Split
- Coach trip to Imotski and around Split
- Meals as stated above
- Teaching

Accommodation is additional. Please refer to the registration form for details.

Costs without transfer and food are 90 Euros or 660 Croatian Kunas.

## Registrations

Please book and pay the fee by 1st April 2016. After this we cannot guarantee accommodation apart from dormitory beds.

## Payments

The fees may be transferred in Euros or Croatian Kunas. The local currency is Croatian Kunas (HRK) and Euros are rarely accepted.

## Cancellations

Cancellations need to be in writing. Before 30th April the fee for the journey will be refunded minus an administration fee of 50 Euros. After this, no refunds are possible

## What to bring

Please bring a notebook and a water bottle.
